

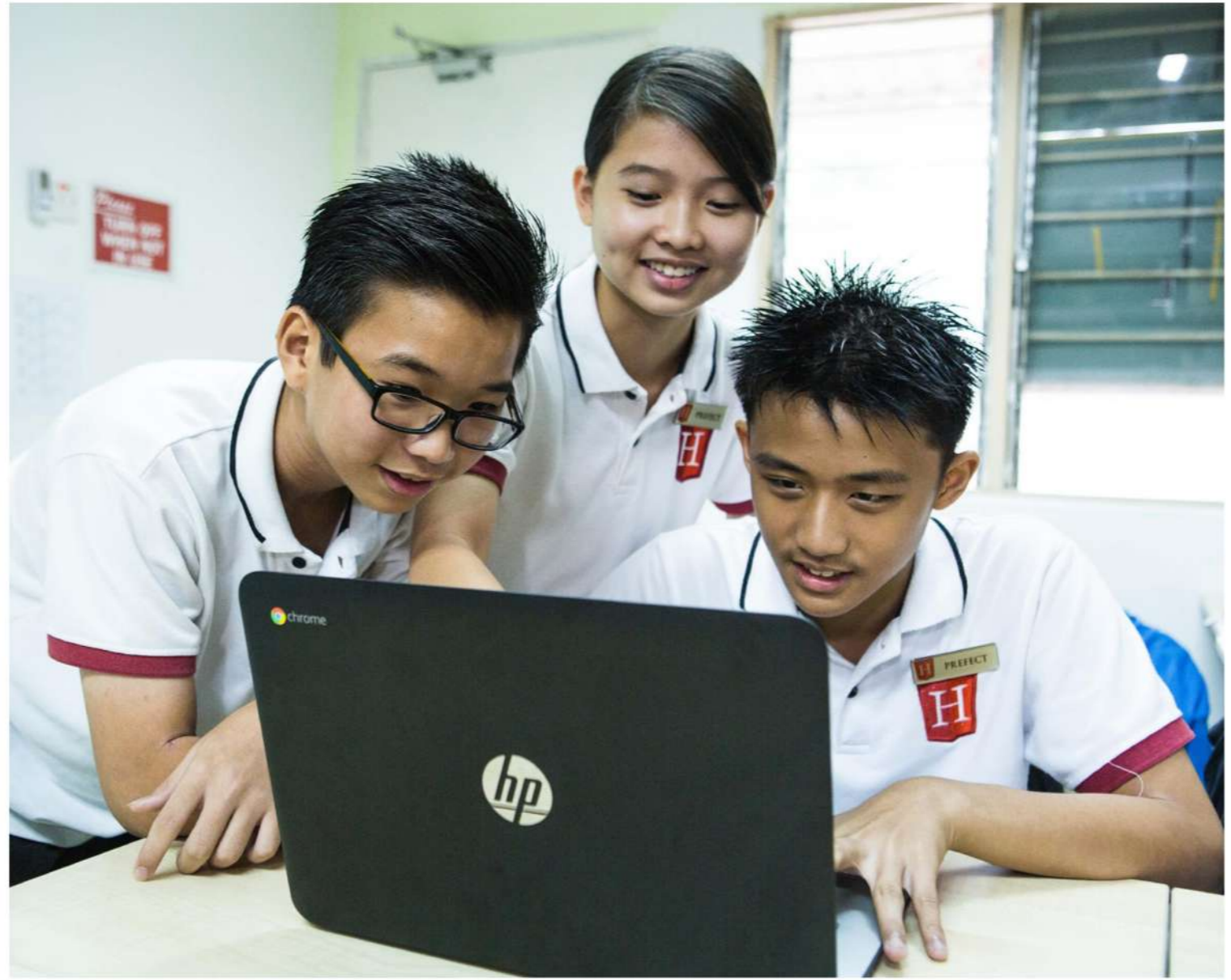

The Cambridge School Curriculum is a well recognised program that is used increasingly in Commonwealth nations.

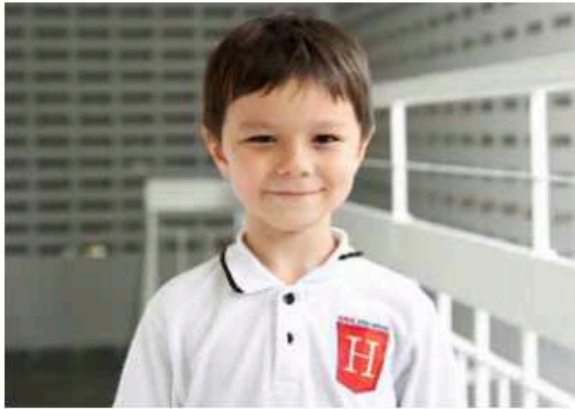

MOTTAINAI FLEA MARKET

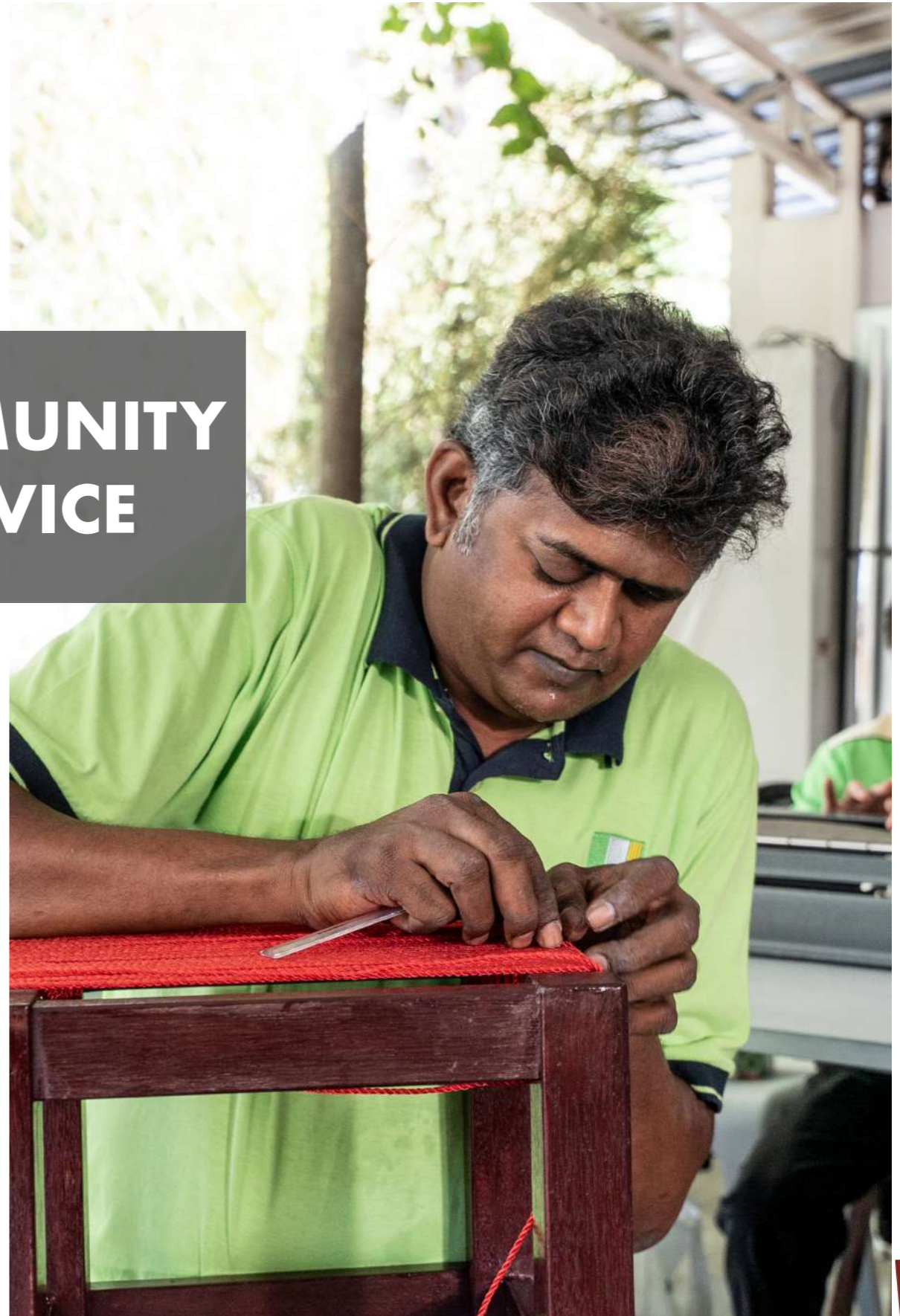

Havil competed in the Kuala Lumpur Floorball League Division 1 after being crowned the champions of KLFL Division 2.





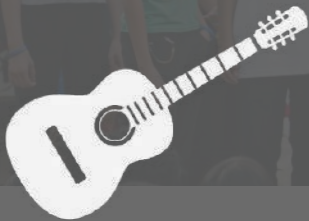
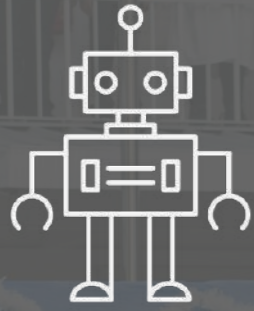
FIELD-TRIPS & CAMPS

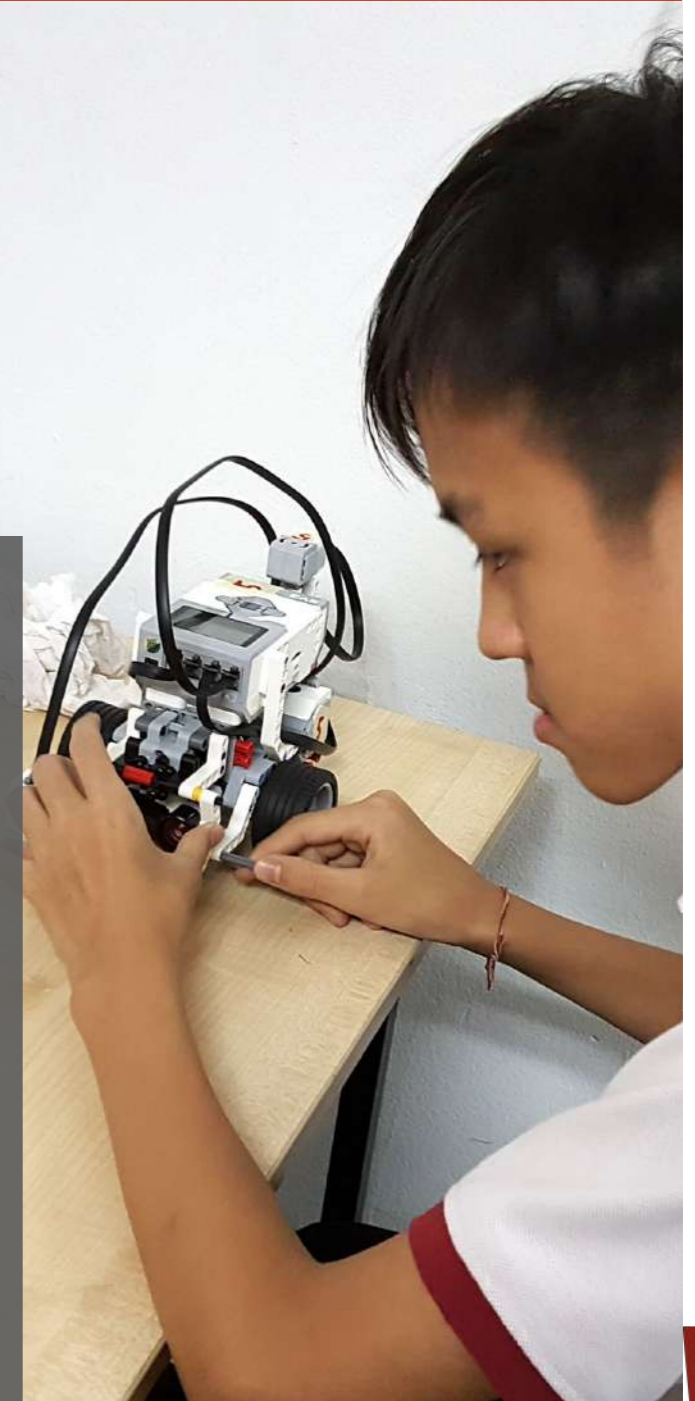
